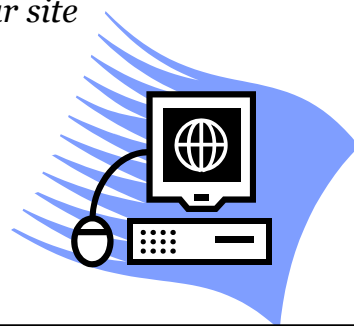

Officer Profiles

Want to get to know your officers better? In each issue of our newsletter, we will include a short profile of a few of our officers so you can get to know them better.

Wilt Greenwood—2nd Vice President

Wilt and his wife Barbara have been motorhoming for about 18 years, since they bought their first rig in 1992 (a much-used Class C without even a generator). Three motorhomes and countless miles later, they bought their first Monaco in 2002 (a 2003 Dynasty) and of course became members of Monaco International. They have both already done a number of jobs for FMCA (they belong to ten FMCA Chapters and have been Rally Masters for the Great Eastern Area Rally), so they were all ready to pitch in for MI as well. They have had some sort of responsibilities at almost every MI Pre-Rally since joining, including organizing the bar at Springfield and handling Chapter Merchandise at Moultrie. Wilt has also served on the MI Nominating Committee, and was most recently one of the Regional Directors for Region 4.

TECH TALK

With our 1st VP—Jerry A. Jenkins

One of the mysteries to many RVers is the real difference between 50 amp and 30 amp service. Everyone knows that 30 amp is less than 50 amp – but do you really know how much difference? And do you know how to properly connect the cord from your motor home to the power pedestal at the camp ground?

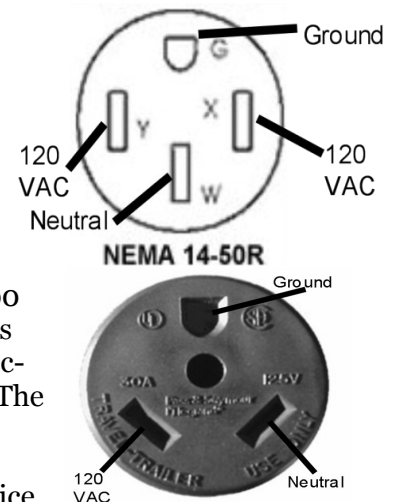
First, let's look at the different outlets we normally use. The slightly larger round outlet with 4 holes is a 50 amp receptacle. It actually provides 2 – 120 volt ac circuits, each with 50 amps of capacity. The resulting power that can be consumed with this plug is 12,000 watts ($2 \times 120 \text{ volts} \times 50 \text{ amps} = 12,000 \text{ watts}$). The round outlet with 3 holes is a 30 amp outlet (I know the picture looks like it has 4, but the round one in the center is a mounting screw hole, not an electrical output). This outlet provides 1 – 120 ac circuit with 30 amps of capacity. The resulting power that can be consumed is 3,600 watts ($1 \times 120 \text{ volts} \times 30 \text{ amps} = 3,600 \text{ watts}$).

When a motor home that has a 50 amp cord is connected to 30 amp service via an adapter cord (sometimes called a dog bone due to its shape), the two circuits in the motor home are both connected to the one circuit available from the 30 amp outlet. The result is the *most* power that can be consumed in the motor home is 3,600 watts. The roof air units consume approximately 15 amps *each*, which is half or 1800 watts of the power available. Obviously, this doesn't leave much room for any other loads.

The charger itself can consume up to 30 amps at 120 volts ac, so it is imperative that the charger be set to limit the load when on a 30 amp service. One idea is to limit the charger to 5 amps and run only one A/C. In addition, turn off the A/C unit when the microwave or any other electrical device is being used.

Any voltage less than 115 VAC should be suspected, but don't try to connect if the voltage is less than 105 VAC. Your coach may have other values for its minimum and 105 VAC may be below the recommended values – if so use the ones from the coach manual. Anytime a motor home power plug is connected, the breaker should be turned off prior to connecting the plug into the outlet. Once connected, you should always check the voltage in the coach using a meter you trust to provide good readings. If the voltage on either leg 1 or leg 2 is lower than around 105 VAC, then damage could occur to the electrical equipment in the coach if power is not disconnected. If the coach has a low voltage protection device and it shuts off the power to the coach, even intermittently, the power should be disconnected from the coach until the power is verified to be ok.

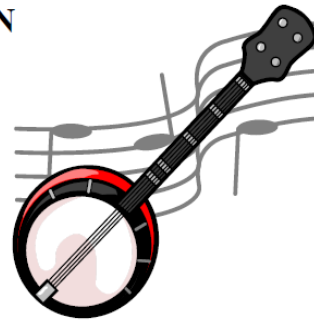

A word from Monaco RV, LLC

It was great to see many of you at the rally in Tucson! I'm happy to have this opportunity to update you on the news from Monaco RV since we were last together.

You probably know that we're currently in production of diesel units in Oregon and gas products in Indiana. Prior to the Tucson rally, we introduced the 2011 Diplomat 43 DFT and the new 40-foot Cayman, which we had just introduced on an eight-airbag chassis. Now, the 2011 Camelot and Dynasty are coming offline and they look great. Slowly but surely, the market for higher-end coaches is returning. We are ready to meet that demand with the kind of value and luxury for which the Monaco brand is known. At the same time, we are focused on success in all aspects of the market place.

You'll be seeing some big developments from Monaco RV over the next several months and I'm excited to give the folks in the Monaco International Club a preview:

We will introduce a new front engine diesel at our dealer meeting in Chicago in July. This is our first new product developed using the extensive design and engineering resources at Navistar. We've used state-of-the art modeling and wind tunnel testing to ensure that this is the most aerodynamic, ergonomic and fuel efficient RV in the industry.

The first coach will be a 32-foot low profile floor plan. It's a great "alternative" RV and an excellent coach for people looking to downsize but retain the luxury they've come to appreciate in a higher line model.

The EPA has tightened emissions standards for diesel engines starting in 2010 and all engine manufacturers will be affected by the new requirements. Most engine makers, including Cummins, have adopted "SCR" technology which requires an additive called urea along with an expensive system of tanks and pumps to handle the new fluid. From what I've been told, there are concerns with urea freezing and evaporating, and if the engine runs out of fluid it just shuts down.

Navistar's MaxxForce engines will instead use "EGR" technology which relies on re-circulating and cooling exhaust to reduce emissions. Owners will not have the expense or inconvenience of dealing with additives and extra tanks. We are starting to make the transition to MaxxForce engines and eventually all our diesel units will use them. In the meantime, we will use up our remaining stock of pre-2010 Cummins engines.

We're starting to send out information about our upcoming Come Home Rally on October 6 – 10, 2010 in conjunction with the Navistar LPGA Classic golf tournament in Prattville, Alabama. At this one-of-a-kind event, the rally will be held next to the golf course and tickets to the tournament are included in the rally registration fee. Between the professional golfers, our own Monaco RV golf event and a wide range of historical outings there will be plenty of fun and action for everyone! I hope to see you all there!

Like all families, the Monaco family has certainly been through our share of ups and downs together. We truly appreciate all the support and good will you've shared with us over the years, which have been invaluable to the success and longevity of the Monaco brand.
