Dear Monaco International Club Members,

It was wonderful to see many of you at the recent rally in Manitowoc, Wisconsin! Those of you who were there got the first chance to see our new 2012 Dynasty. This beautiful 40' coach with a bath and a half was quite popular and was the first unit to sell at the show. We also showed several other gorgeous new models that have been completely restyled in partnership with Navistar's incredible engineering and design resources. You'll get a chance to see all these coaches at upcoming shows and on dealer lots in the near future.

During the rally, Monaco RV announced news that we are consolidating motorized production to our Wakarusa, Indiana facility. We want it to be as easy as possible for you to get the assistance you've become accustomed to.

Change isn't always easy, but we view these as part of our larger mission to provide our customers with the best RVs and the best customer service in the industry. I can promise you that our commitment to your satisfaction is something that will never change.




