Happy New Year from all of us here at Monaco RV! It has been a while since Manitowoc, Wisconsin. Since Wisconsin, we have introduced our 2012 Knight and 2012 Diplomat. They both have a new look along with a new diesel engine with our new partnership of Navistar and Maxxforce. Our new 2012 Dynasty is doing great, too. We have built 6 new Dynasty's and 5 of them have already sold at the dealers. We have 21 more that we are building with the ISX 650 Cummins. These are the last of the ISX engines. Our motorized products are doing extremely well.

Since our last newsletter, we have opened another service center and working on a few others. We opened the Wakarusa Service center in November 2011. We are working with our Wildwood, Florida dealer for an exclusive service center. Furthermore, we are in discussions on another location in the Southwest part of the country. Our goal is to obtain company-owned service centers throughout the United States for convenience to our owners when servicing their coaches becomes necessary.

We are diligently working on the transition from our Coburg, Oregon motorized operation to the centralized Wakarusa motorized facility. During the transition, we are going to be building in both locations for four weeks to ensure that we keep new coaches in our dealers. The last unit out of Coburg Oregon will come off-line the end of April.

On a personal note, we appreciate your support during this tough transition for all of us in Oregon. It is a rough transition for all, including myself. It is a business decision that needed us to consolidate all to one facility. We are taking some of our people from Oregon but will be leaving many here. We will continue to commit to making sure that you "our customers" are satisfied with our product through our pillars of customer service, quality, and innovation.

National Directors Report

If you have not made plans to attend the 87th FMCA Family Reunion and Motor home Showcase – August 27 – 30, 2012 Indiana State Fairgrounds in Indianapolis, Indiana I urge you to go on line and register now. As of this date, the dates and exact location for the 88th FMCA convention have not been confirmed; however, an announcement with full details should be made within the next couple of weeks.

Several positions within the FMCA office have changed since the August 2011 Governing Board meeting. Brad Koshland, Executive director has resigned due to family commitments. Jerry Yeatts, has assumed the position of Executive Director as well as Membership/Member Services. We wish him the best in his new position, particularly during these difficult times. Changes in staff numbers as well as positions have resulted in a considerable savings to FMCA/FMC amounting to approximately \$268,000.

Many budget items have been reviewed and additional cuts have been made in order to make every attempt to balance the budget. Various contracts have been scrutinized and have resulted in considerable savings such as in cleaning and garbage services. These two combined have produced a savings in excess of \$21,000.00.

While some of these figures may not seem like a great amount, it does show that our President and Executive Board, as well as the staff of FMCA have been working diligently to cut costs while continuing to offer the members services and benefits, which we have been accustomed to over the years. We all need to consider the times and the financial crisis in our entire country that affects us daily.

One way in which you as a member of MI and FMCA can help is to put forth every effort to help preserve our membership and solicit new members. The membership has dropped significantly in FMCA.....consider the total membership in FMCA as of January, 2011 was 93,466.....As of January 1, 2012 the total membership is 85,879. This translates to a loss of 7, 587 FMCA members for the past year. We cannot continue to lose members at this rate. Do your part and invite motor home owners that you see in campgrounds, etc. to join FMCA. We need to work together to preserve our lifestyle and continue to enjoy rallies and conventions.

Nominating Committee Report

Normally there is a progression from 2nd VP to 1st VP and 1st VP to President; therefore if this is followed the 2nd VP position must be filled in addition to the term limited positions below:

Treasurer

Region 1 – one director

Region 2 – two directors

Region 3 – one director

Region 5 – one director

However, all positions on the board are up for re-election and anyone may submit their name for consideration to any position, regardless if there is someone in the position that is not term limited.

<u>Important News – Changes Coming to the</u> <u>Michelin Tire Program</u>

Michelin is changing the process for paying for tires purchased under the Monaco International Tire Program. *Effective February 12, 2012, any member wishing to purchase tires must register their credit card with Michelin prior to the purchase.*

To register your card, you must call customer service and give them your full credit card number along with the billing information. This will allow you to make *one* purchase with your credit card within a 30 day period after making the call. After the 30 day period, your card information is



removed from their system completely. If you wish to make more than one purchase during the 30 day period or any other time, simply call customer service for each purchase required. The system is real time, so you can actually purchase immediately after calling.

Michelin is making this change to put them in compliance with the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS) and to make customers' credit card data safer. The process is new and subject to change as we learn more of how to comply with Michelin's new rules for credit card processing so check the our web site for the latest information.

<u>Instructions to Register a Credit Card for</u> <u>Michelin Tire Purchases:</u>

To register your credit card for tire purchases:

- 1. Call (800) 382-2456
- 2. Press option 9: you will prompted to enter our ship to number and use the zip code 78028
- 3. Press option 3 to speak to a National Account Representative
- 4. Tell the representative that you are with Monaco International RV Club and wish to register a credit card so that you can make a one-time purchase of tires using our National Account.
- 5. If they ask you to use "B2B" or any other method, tell them you don't have access and need them to register the card for you.

You will need to furnish the follow information to register your card:

- Our Ship to number which is on your Monaco International Membership Card
- Credit card number to be used
- Name on credit card
- Expiration date of credit card
- Zip code used for billing on the credit card
- Phone number where you can you can be reached in case of any issues.
- 6. Once you have completed this process, you may purchase tires using the first digit and the last four digits of your card, name on the card, and expiration date of the card.
- 7. There can be only **one** purchase made by the card per call to customer service and the card will not be valid within Michelin after 30 days. If you wish to make multiple purchases, call customer service before each purchase.




